

## TWENTY FIRST CENTURY COMMUNICATIONS AND VIDEO ACCESSIBILITY ACT OF 2010 STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE

- We provide emergency information in a manner that is accessible to people who are blind or visually impaired.
- We provide video descriptions and emergency information on devices with screens smaller than 13 inches that is accessible to people who are blind or visually impaired, if technical feasible and achievable.
- We provide devices designed to record TV programs to pass through closed captions, video descriptions and emergency information so viewers can turn on/off the closed captions and make video descriptions and emergency information audible
- We provide interconnection mechanisms to carry the information necessary to permit the display of closed captions and make video decryption and emergency information audible.
- We provide remote controls for TVs and other video programming devices to be accessible to people who are blind or visually impaired and have a button designated for activating closed captioning and video description.
- We provide on-screen text menus and program guides displayed on TV by set-top boxes to be
  accessible to people who are blind or visually impaired and have a button designated for
  activating closed captioning.
- We provide audible accessibility reading for set-top boxes.
- We enable consumers to adjust closed captions in a variety of ways, including their color (both text and background color), size, fonts, opacity, edge attributes and language selection.
